BMI

1) The Hue Of Bluu

I've always loved and cherished the different shades, colorations, and variations on blue. It exemplifies royalty, spirituality, tranquility, and a sublime energy, which remains on simmer, but can fire up on a moment's notice. Wally and Davis create masterful solos followed by myself on alto saxophone.

2) Valley Of The Bluu Rose

The rose exists in different shades and colors, however the blue has the strongest scent. Its fragrance is penetrating and quite captivating. This song serves as an improvisational vehicle for myself on soprano saxophone and Wally on trumpet.

3) Planet Bluu

This composition was originally composed on the kalimba, which provided me the melodic material for the "*Pt*" sections. I later used the piano to find the right harmonic sequence for the melody and to create a bridge connecting these "*Pt*" sections.

4) Crystal Lake Bluu

Picture a fresh-water lake on top of a plateau whose waters are pristine boasting over one hundred feet of visibility. The sanza is very important in establishing the mood as well as shell master Steve Turre. I added the alto flute in conversation with the shells to create an ebullient dialogue.

5) SKY Bluu Part 1

The opening statement is played on the lukembi, followed by a repetition of this melodic line on alto saxophone. Using the piano I composed a harmonic movement to accompany the melody and improvisation.

6) Sky Bluu Part 2

The repetitive line played by the lukembi is echoed with the trumpet and alto saxophone along with a dynamic rhythmic accompaniment. Sky's the limit within the realm of creativity.

7) When It's Time To Say Goodbye (Hale Smith)

Maestro Hale was my teacher upon my return to the USA after living in Paris close to nine years. I read about Mr. Smith's work as a composer

and arranger while attending undergraduate school at NYU. After moving to Paris, France I recorded my first project as a leader entitled Egyptian Oasis, which included one of Hale's compositions: I Love Music. To meet Hale a few years later was quite serendipitous, as his compositions are extremely compelling. His wife Juanita is like a godmother and I visit her in Long Island quite frequently. "When it's Time To Say Goodbye" is a beautiful ballad and one of Juanita's favorite songs composed by her husband. It was recorded in her honor, and featured during Juanita's retirement party at the United Nations. I am equally blessed to have an extraordinary pianist join me on this version named Dave Kikoski.

8) Chessman's Delight (Randy Weston)

NEA Jazz Master Dr. Randy Weston had a profound influence on my career and I am forever grateful for his unwavering support and encouragement. Like myself, Dr. Weston's favorite color was blue, and his most famous and lucrative recording was Blue Moses. Baba recorded another project entitled "Blue" I love the game of chess and decided to include this composition on Planet Bluu. Everyone gets a taste on this track including master trombonist and special guest Steve Turre.

9) Turquoise Bluu

Since my childhood I've always had a profound affinity for turquoise. Its shading and coloration of blue has hints of elegance, royalty, spirituality, and reverence. Composed in 7 / 4 yields hints of perpetual motion. The band creates a cyclic motion and energy that supports creative and spontaneous composition.

10) Royal Bluu

This composition is in duo with myself on kalimba and Orion Turre on drums. Orion plays exceptionally comfortable across 6 / 8 rhythms.

11) The Blue Sea Of Our Tomorrows

This composition serves as a vehicle for spontaneous composition with the piano and alto saxophone. I created three different horn lines, which are layered. This creates some tension, which reflects adversity we all experience as we navigate through life. A blue unpolluted sea of immaculate waters represents the joy and optimism that we will eventually arrive at our destination unspoiled and unharmed. Our future is bright and filled with buoyancy.
